ICH Key Points:

- Historically, European states put greater emphasis on protecting built heritage and intellectual property.
- Thus the more subtle, consistent erosion of unique ICH in these countries, driven strongly by globalisation and cultural homogenisation, has received little attention.
- Research will proceed by creating a theoretical compass for value of ICH and continue by analysing the following case examples:
 - * governmental regulation of tartan in Scotland;
 - domestic cultural branding in Ireland;
 - * and community driven language and festival revivals in Wales.
